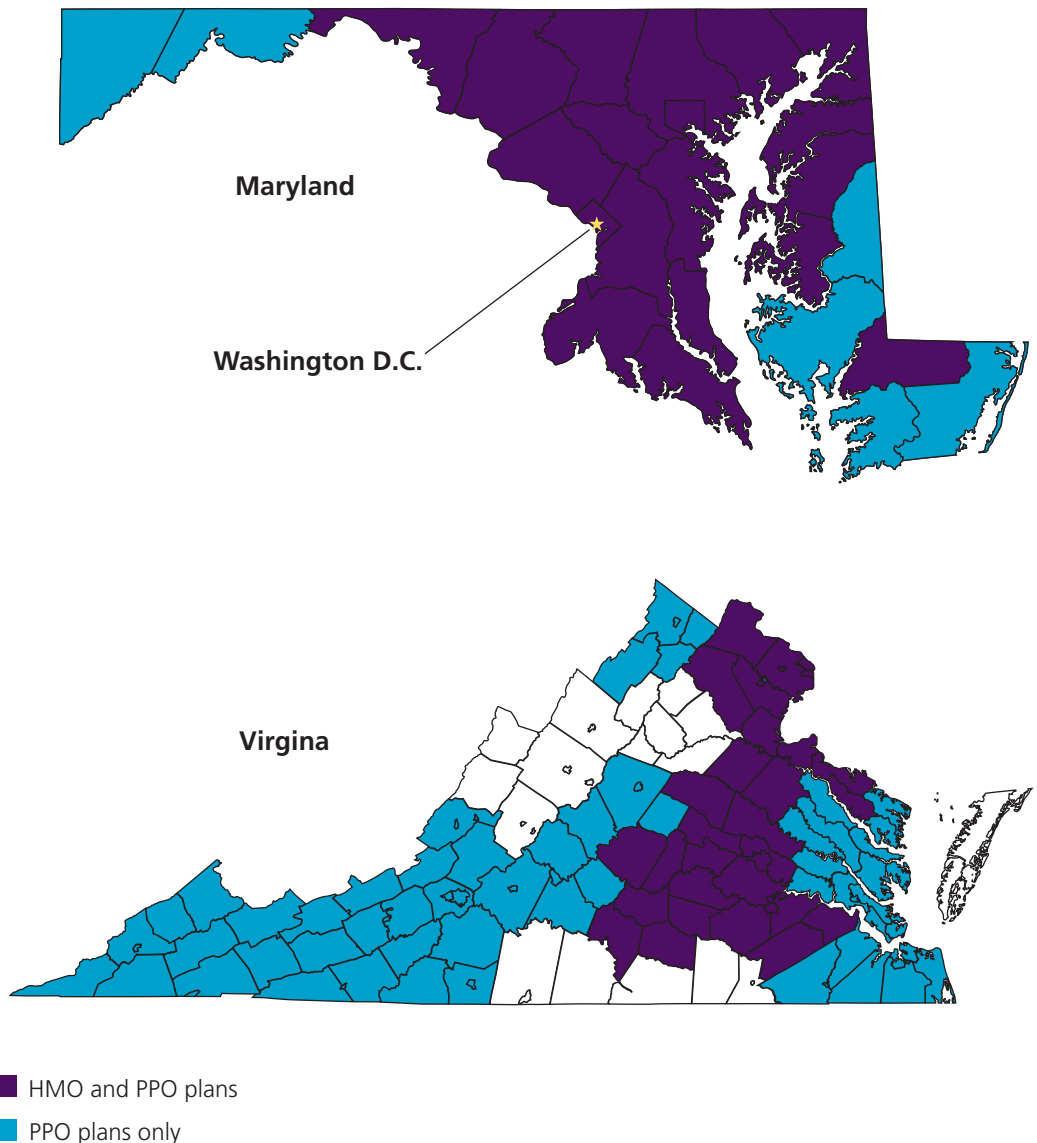

Follow these easy steps to find a provider in your area

DocFind

Locating a participating doctor has never been easier — with our DocFind® online provider directory. You can search for participating physicians, hospitals, pharmacies, dentists and eyewear outlets. DocFind also lets you search by zip code, distance from home, city and state, or county and state.

Narrow your search by specialty, hospital affiliation and/or languages spoken — all with a few clicks of a mouse. Best of all, DocFind is updated regularly and is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

To search for providers by city, zip, or county:

- Go to www.aetna.com/docfind/home.do. Under “Shortcuts” select “Find a Doctor”
- Scroll down to “General Search” and enter the requested criteria. You can search by zip, city or county.
 - >Select the provider category
 - >Select the provider type
 - >Select the desired plan

Select Aetna Standard Plans

- >For HMO health benefits plans — select “HMO”
- >For POS or No-Referral POS health benefits and health insurance plans — select “QPOS”
- >For PPO health insurance plans — select “Open Choice PPO”

Select Aetna HealthFund® Plans

- >For Aetna Health Network Option AHF HRA — select “Aetna Health Network Option (Aetna HealthFund)”
- You may choose to narrow your search results. If not, select “Start Search.” Your search results will contain:
 - >Provider name, address and phone number
 - >Provider specialty (if appropriate)
 - >Link to MapQuest website to access provider location
 - >Link to more provider details (such as hospital affiliation, languages spoken, etc.)
- From the Search Results page, you may select a “Printer Friendly Version.” This option will consolidate your search results into a mini-directory and provide a printer-friendly PDF you may download or print.

These will not be regional averages or estimates, but actual cost ranges based upon negotiated rates for a specific facility. They will include the costs from admission to discharge, for the facility and the doctor — and for ancillary fees, such as the services of an anesthesiologist.

Only Aetna members registered with Aetna Navigator® can access transparency information — unit price transparency, clinical quality and efficiency information, as well as the Medical Procedure by Facility Cost tool. This information is not available on the Aetna public websites.
